## "IF" clauses

If I had money, I would buy a house.

If I bought a house, I would take my parents there.

If I took my parents there, they would be very happy.

If they were very glad, I would be very content, too.

## **Cause and Effect: Chain**

I got "0" on the exam because I did not study.

I did not study because I did not have time.

I did not have time because I went to a party.

I went to the party because my friend invited me.

My friend invited me because he would not go alone.
